☐ To figure the size of truck you'll need, take all non-boxable items and add 15 percent to their combined cubic feet (along with the total cubic feet of boxes to be loaded).	
3 Weeks Before	
Assemble all packing materials such as packing tape, scissors, utility knife, markers, and boxes.	
☐ Start packing items you won't need. Be careful not to put too much weight in any of the boxes.	
☐ Get new driver's license, registration, and insurance if needed.	
☐ Schedule a cancellation date for utilities and service at your old home, and arrange for service to begin at your new home.
